Bearded dragons are omnivorous, eating a variety of live prey and vegetable matter in the wild. Balancing a diet, which mirrors a bearded dragon's natural food in the wild, is difficult in captivity. Farm raised feeder insects and grocery store produce are limited in nutritional value and guessing on the amount of vitamin/mineral supplementation necessary can be detrimental to the long-term health of your pet.

Product Application & Storage

- Formulated as a complete maintenance diet for bearded dragons, this diet should be fed free choice. Bearded Dragons will learn to eat from dishes if initially mixed with green vegetables. Fresh green leaves and vegetables may be offered as an occasional treat but should constitute only a minor portion of the diet. Fresh clean water should be available at all times.
- Shelf Life: Two (2) years from date of manufacture
- Store in a cool, dry area away from sunlight. Rotate stock to use oldest feed first. "First in, first out" principle.
